Entries now open, and some changes to the Rockfish Junior Dinghy Series

Dear Friends of Dartmouth Royal Regatta Sailing Week,

I am pleased to let you know that **entries are now open** for the 2023 Dartmouth Royal Regatta Sailing Week, 19th – 27th August. Entries can be submitted online at webcollect.org.uk/dartmouthsailingweek, or see dartmouthsailingweek.com/Race-documents/ if you prefer to download and print a paper entry form.

The Notice of Race has recently been published for the **Rockfish Junior Dinghy Series**, and is available at dartmouthsailingweek.com/Race-documents/. This year, the series will take place over 3 days (rather than 4 as in the past), but the number of races will be increased to 3 races per day. This will give an extra race overall and a better experience to the competitors, and we hope that parents will find the schedule more convenient.

One-design classes are expected for Toppers, Teras and Fevas, and (*new this year*) entries are also invited from other junior dinghies for a PY handicap class. For less experienced sailors, training may be provided for those not familiar with racing.

Racing will start on Sunday 20th and run to Tuesday 22nd August. The times of racing will vary daily to make best use of the tide, which will mean an early start on Sunday, and racing completed by lunchtime each day.

The fees for the juniors have been restructured in line with our other events, and an early-bird discount will be available up to the 31st July. This offers a substantial reduction compared with last year's fee for those entering the whole series.

A quick reminder that if you will need **accommodation on shore**, we strongly recommend early booking, as there is huge demand during Regatta Week.
