There will be three course areas – the Inner, Middle and Outer – These are illustrated in Appendix B of the SIs.




The first scheduled warning signal of the day for all courses is **10:25** except **Bay Race** day when it is **10:55**.

The following tables show the allocation of classes/divisions to courses, class flags and default starting order.

The starting order may be changed by the Race Officer. An interval may also be introduced between each start sequence. This will be announced by VHF radio (SI 3.4) at least 10 minutes before the first warning signal of any series of start sequences.




