Dear Friends of Dartmouth Royal Regatta Sailing Week,

Last day today for the Rockfish Junior Dinghy Series! The weather wasn't very kind to them with a nasty squall hitting just as they finished their 3rd race on Saturday, but better on Sunday with two races completed before the tide became too strong. They've had fun and enjoyed some competitive racing, with a warm welcome to many visiting boats and a record Topper fleet of 19 boats. Their prize giving will be this afternoon, about 14:30 at RDYC. Some of them will be back on the water for the Demonstration Dinghy Race which takes place this afternoon off the South Embankment. Do come along and show your support for both occasions.

Meanwhile at Dittisham, entries for the Moore Kingston Smith Dinghy Series fell only slightly below last year's record, but a record of 33 in the Solo fleet. They too were hit by that squall which curtailed their second race of the day, but both visitors and local club members enjoyed 2 races yesterday. Both RDYC in Kingswear and DYC in Dartmouth are looking forward to welcoming competitors in the Yacht Racing which starts tomorrow with the Savills Passage Race. At RDYC, breakfasts will be available from Wednesday, lunches and crew suppers every day from 17:00 (RDYC Members please use SmartClub and non-members click [here](#)). DYC will be serving food from their partners at Bushells Riverside, both in the club and on the riverside terrace, from 12:00-15:00 & 18:00-21:00.

Late entries for the Savills Passage Race or the Yacht and Dayboat Series are open until 17:00 the day before the race - but if intending to enter in the **Cruiser classes** please ensure you have a **2024 RYA YTC certificate before** submitting your entry (*Dayboat class cancelled due to lack of entries*). For those not racing tomorrow, why not enjoy a walk on the coast path at Berry Head or Froward Point to watch the Savills Passage Race (starts from Brixham at 14:00).
