Start/Finish line

Start by crossing the Blackstone Point Transit line from N to S using Castle Ledge buoy as the Outer Distance mark. White Sail yachts will start between 1000 and 1100 hrs; Gaffers between 1030 and 1045.

Finish by crossing the same line from S to N.

Entrants must accurately record the times they cross the line at start and finish. These may also be verified from course boat Bravo, flying an orange flag. **Additionally, the time of rounding each mark indicated below should also be recorded for both laps** (and may be used as the finish time should the course be shortened).

The Course Cruisers and Gaffers 2 Laps

Entrants must keep clear of the Inner Course Racing Area used by other classes.

The course is as follows:-

Start	Blackstone Point Transit	Lap 1 Time	Lap 2 Time
Mark 1	RDYC 4 (leave to starboard)
Mark 2	RDYC 3 (leave to starboard)
Mark 3	Homestone (leave to starboard)
Mark 4	Castle Ledge (leave to starboard)

Then finish as described above.
