Entries are already well up compared to the same time last year, so we are confident of a good turn out and some strong competition.

The **Moore Kingston Smith Dinghy Series** will again offer superb racing hosted at Dittisham Sailing Club, and the **Rockfish Junior Dinghy Series** at RDYC provides an exciting introduction to regatta racing for under-16s. For those preferring a more relaxed style of sailing, we are introducing a new 'Corinthian' format for our **White Sail and Gaffer Events** on Friday and Saturday. With each day arranged like a Pursuit Race, boats will be allocated a start time according to handicap (with slower boats starting first), and all will sail until a fixed finish time. As the later starters gain on the earlier boats, there should be an exciting last leg as the clock ticks down. The boat ahead on the water at the finish time is the winner, and all boats still on the course will get a score.
